DIRECTIONS TO Stormin' G Ranch, 7001 Sebesta Lane, College Station, TX 77845

From George Bush Drive & Welborn Road:

- Head Southeast on FM-2154/Welborn Road for 7.2 mi.
- Turn Right on Straub Rd.
- Continue on Straub Rd, will turn into Stousland Rd.
- Continue until stop sign.
- Turn Right at stop sign to continue on Stousland Rd.
- Continue approximately 1.4 mi and turn left on Taylor Rd.
- Immediately there will be a road to the right with a cattle guard called Sebesta Lane. Cross the cattle guard and continue to the covered arena on left.
- Park along the circle drive or the road.
