

Seminar Dates: July 9-10,2016 Location: <u>Hilltop Farm, Inc</u>

This Seminar is an introduction to life on the breeding farm. It is geared to youth and young adults. The seminar will provide an overview of the many aspects involved in breeding and raising top sport horses. This educational program will include demonstrations on mare and stallion management, training the horse in hand, evaluating gaits and the progression of training from starting young horse to FEI level.

Eligibility:

- > Applications will be approved on a first come basis
- > Applicants must be between the ages of 14-27
- > Applicants under 18 will be required to be accompanied by a guardian
- > Each applicant (regardless of age) will be allowed one guardian or guest
- Guardians/guests will be charged a fee to cover meals and refreshments
- The application must be accompanied by payments and all signed releases to be considered.

Seminar Content:

- Learn about life on a breeding farm
- Discussions on conformation and movement
- Mare management session watching an ultrasound and seeing new foals
- Stallion Management including semen collection and processing
- > Training the horse in hand demonstrations with different young horses
- Evaluating gaits demonstrations with live horses
- > Development of the foal
- > Training the young horse 3-yr-old to FEI level
- > Lunch and Saturday evening meal provided
