RIDER CRITERIA

Riders must be 14-21 years of age. Riders ages 12-14 competing in FEI Pony classes may also apply. Riders must have a USDF Youth Participating or Life Membership. They must also have a USEF Active Competing Junior, Senior, or Life Membership. Riders must submit an online application, riding video, and \$25 application fee before the specified rider deadline.

AUDITORS

Auditors of all ages are welcome. Pre-registration is strongly encouraged to facilitate planning. Pre-registered auditors will be on the registration list provided to the organizer and pre-printed name tags, available at the clinic, will serve as their tickets. Walk-in auditors are also welcome. There will be registration forms and blank name tags at the registration desk. Auditors should plan to bring a chair, if possible.

DIRECTIONS

From Interstate 25: Turn east on Colorado 470 (tolls) or Lincoln Avenue (no tolls) about 4 miles to Route 83, also known as Parker Road. Go south through the town of Parker. Continue to Bayou Gulch Road and turn left past Ponderosa High School. Show entrance will be located on your left.

From Interstate 70 Eastbound: Take Colorado 470 (tolls) until you reach Route 83 or Parker Road. Go south through the town of Parker. Continue to Bayou Gulch Road and turn left past Ponderosa High School. Show entrance will be located on your left.

From Interstate 70 Westbound: Turn west onto Route 86, just west of Limon. Continue towards Franktown intersection and turn north (right) onto Route 83 or Parker Road. Travel approximately three miles and turn right on Bayou Gulch Road. The show entrance will be located on your left.
